The Hirst Landry award is only for students who plan on pursuing a career in the visual arts. This application is portfolio based and is in line with what most post-secondary institutions require for their submissions. Even if you are not selected to receive this award, some or all of this application could be used in your application portfolio to post-secondary institutions.

Submit 5 images (jpg or pdf) of artwork completed in the last 1-2 years.

- Make selections that represent your interests and skills.
- Work can include 2D and 3D work using traditional or non-traditional materials. Make selections that best represent your diversity of interests and skills. Select and use materials and techniques that suit your ideas.
- At least 50% of your portfolio work should be original, self-directed projects (not projects from a class)
- Talk to your art teacher about how to take photos of your work, or look online for “how to take photos of artwork”
- 1MB or less per image.
- Name images: First Name Last Name #. For example: “John Smith 1”

Submit a 5-10 pg pdf of sketchbook work.

- The pages could be of ideas that you are exploring, research for projects or skills you are trying to reflect. The drawings do not need to be complete.
- Use any method you like to make the pdf, but an easy way is to paste an image of one drawing per page in a word document and then save as a pdf.
- Name it: First Name Last Name Sketchbook. For example: “John Smith Sketchbook”

Submission email:

- In the subject line write: First name Last Name. Eg: “John Smith”
- In the message portion include a paragraph that is no more than 200 words that states what kind of art you like to make best, the visual career you are planning for, and the post secondary institutions and programs you are applying to.
- Also include a list of the images you are submitting that includes the following for each:

First Name Last Name #

“Title”

Width x height (x depth if 3D)

materials

Eg

John Smith 1

“Figure in Blue”

18x 24”

Oil on canvas

- You will need to send several emails in order to include all of the images as attachments. Subsequent subject lines should be: Last name First Name 1, 2, 3 etc. For eg: “John Smith 1. “

Alternate methods for submission: If you belong to a file storage site online (for eg: Dropbox) send submission email with paragraph and list of works as well as a link to a folder that has the 6 portfolio files.
