- Grads should come to the ceremony dressed in their gown with appropriate attire: black dress pants/ skirts/ dresses, white dress shirt, and dress shoes. Students KEEP their grad gowns, caps, and stoles.
- If you want to take pictures at the Coliseum, arrive early and take the pictures with your family before the ceremony.
