PHE – Swimming and Lifesaving 9-11

Prerequisite: Swimming Proficiency is required - Students must be able to swim 100m continuously in less than 3 minutes prior to taking the course.

Description: The course will include a variety of Aquatic activities (swimming, water rescue, etc). This is a pre-employment program in partnership with the YMCA, and the course will be scheduled for 2-3 classes per week at the Cheam pool. Throughout the duration of the course, students will be given instruction towards attaining their Bronze Medallion, Bronze Cross, and Standard First Aid certifications (if they don't already have them). These are all the prerequisites for the National Lifeguard course.

- PHE Swimming and Lifesaving 10 fulfills the prescribed graduation requirement for PHE 10
- PHE Swimming and Lifesaving 11 fulfills a grade 11 elective course credit.
